Nominal Course Duration

Description

This course is aimed at personnel who have undertaken asbestos removal training previously and intend to supervise asbestos removal for a licensed asbestos removalist. This unit of competency is recognised by Safe Work NSW for licencing purposes.

Workers (including the asbestos removal supervisors) who are carrying out licensed asbestos removal work are required to acquire a certification by completing units of competencies to show they have the relevant training to be able to remove asbestos. The units of competency completed by the person will determine what type of asbestos work they can carry out. Asbestos removal supervisors will have additional units of competency to complete.

Training Subjects & Practical Exercises

- Ensuring an asbestos removalist supervisor is readily available or present when the work is being carried out
- Providing appropriate training and ensuring the asbestos removal worker has undertaken the relevant units of competencies associated with the asbestos removal
- Telling various parties about the asbestos removal and providing them with appropriate information
- Obtaining the workplace's asbestos register
- Preparing an asbestos removal control plan
- Notifying the regulator about the work before it starts
- Displaying signs and labels in the asbestos work area
- Limiting access to the asbestos work area
