This course is aimed at personnel who have not undertaken any confined space training previously or their existing confined space qualifications have been undertaken more than 4 years ago. This full accreditation confined space training course is designed for all persons involved in confined space entry. With successful completion of this course the participants will be qualified to fulfil any role (entrant, standby or rescue) in the confined space entry team.

This course is designed for **medium to high risk** confined space entry. Medium to high risk confined space entries are for any confined space where there is a potential for the atmosphere or the atmosphere in the confined space is oxygen deficient, has toxic contaminants that exceed the exposure standards and has the potential to be flammable.
