14. Why do you need to pay attention to proper hygiene and standard infection control procedures?
15. What information will you find in the Australian Resuscitation Council guidelines?
16. What does it mean if a patient responds to the talk and touch method?
17. What technique should you use to check a casualty's airway?
18. Why is the recovery position the best position for a casualty who is unconscious and breathing?
19. What should you do if the casualty is not breathing normally and there are no signs of life?
20. Where is the correct hand position on a casualty's chest for providing compressions?
21. What is the ratio of chest compressions to breaths when performing CPR?
22. What depth should your chest compressions go to on the casualty?
23. According to the ARC guidelines, how should you adapt compressions for infants?
24. Why shouldn't CPR rotations be done more frequently than every 2 minutes?
25. What are the 6 links in the chain of survival?
26. Identify the 5 steps for using an AED.
27. Identify the manner in which you should provide details to emergency response services.
28. What method will generally be used to provide incident and casualty details to your workplace supervisor?
